

Following the issue of the dull black, hard to read overprints, Dollard was contracted to reprint the three worst issues with red ink. On April 1, 1922, the Dollard red ink issues appeared in the post offices. They were comprised of the 2 ½ pence, 4 pence and 9 pence issues.

On July 12, 1922, Dollard Printing House lost the printing contract to Thom & Sons Printers. The "carmine" overprints appeared right after that, making it likely that Thom was printing them with there own signature carmine ink and using the original Dollard plates. 2 ½ pence has never been seen with carmine ink, just the 4 pence and 9 pence.
