Tsar's Declaration Overprint

The initial declaration of Tsar Nicholas II's abdication of the throne of Russia was printed in the Bulletin of the Petrograd Soviet (Council) of Workers and Soldiers Deputies on March 4, 1917 as a broadside to be posted and free of charge. It was reproduced on formular postal cards atop an orange image of the French symbol of revolution, a man wearing a Phyrgian hat, with sword and text "Brotherhood, Equality and Liberty", slogans of the 1789-99 French Revolution.



[Partial text on card] ABDICATION FROM THE THRONE

Telegram transmitted to Commander in Chief of the Navy, Captain 1⁸ Class, Count Keppist and to Commander in Chief of the Baltic Fleet, Vice Admiral Nepomochni.

Text of the Declaration:

"In the days of great struggle against the the foreign enemy who has been trying for three years to enslave our country, it is the Will of Heaven to send a new strenuous trial for all Russians.

In accordance with the State Duma, We acknowledge it is best to abdicate the Throne of Russia and to resign from the High Command. As We do not wish to part from our dearest son, We pass on the legacy to our brother Grand Duke Michael Alexandrovich with our blessings on him to ascend the throne.

We appeal to all our faithful sons of the Fatherland to fulfil their Holy Duty to it in obedience to the Tsar in his grave moment of trial for all the peoples and to help him, together with the peoples representatives and to lead Russia on a road of Victory, Prosperity and Glory. May God help Russia.

Nicholas 2nd March, 15.00 hours, 1917, Pskov.

Tsar's Declaration Overprint

Not surprising, doubled overprints are found on the blocks of twelve as well.



Overprints on Postal Stationery

Setting 3 is found on postal stationery letter cards that do not commemorate the Romanov dynasty. The stamp or the Imperial logo of the double-headed eagle may be overprinted.





Early in 1946, the Manchukuo Yuan was replaced by the North-Eastern Yuan.
