UNITED STATES COLONIAL CURRENCY NOTES

(Continental currency was authorized on May 10, 1775 in a session of the Continental Congress and became the first federally issued paper money, predating the official birth of the United States by more than a full year. Continental currency is particularly historic because its issuance helped finance the American Revolution. The notes were styled after Pennsylvania notes in use at that time and circulated alongside colonial paper currency issued by the individual colonies)(CC-97) 150.00
