- 1147 1912 (17 Mar) red-band cover from a Chinese merchant in "Okino-Klyuchi" to Sanchuan, Shansi, via Peking, franked with 10k Imperial fiscal adhesive, tied by a violet departure pmk, showing "Bichura" transit and oval "Bichura Doplatit" postage due, with "10k" inserted by hand (the fiscal stamp was not valid for international mail), with Peking, Taiyuanfu, Fengchow transit and Sanchuan arrival pmks, censured at Manchuria, with type 4 cachets in red, fine and remarkable usage from a small village of Okino-Klyuchi, north of Kyachta, present day Buryatia 500.00
- 1148 1912 (19 Jan) red-band cover from a Chinese merchant in "Okino-Klyuchi" to Sanchuan, Shansi, via Peking, franked with 10k dark blue tied by a violet departure pmk, showing "Bichura" transit and oval "Bichura" cds, with Peking (9 Feb), Taiyuanfu, Fengchow transit and Sanchuan arrival pmks, fine and remarkable usage from a small village of Okino-Klyuchi, north of Kyachta, present day Buryatia, with clear transit and arrival pmks 500.00
- 1149 Ship Mail. 1899 (28 July) cover to Germany, franked with 10k dark blue (horizontally laid paper) sent probably from Vladivostok, via Gensan, Korea, where framed "Paquebot" was applied, the stamp itself was canceled in Nagasaki, Japan, eventually reaching Leipzig on 7 September, v.f. ship letter, signed Holcombe, with his 1992 certificate, ex-Liphschutz 250.00
- 1150 1911 (6 Oct) picture postcard (Chinese Year of the Sheep) franked with 4k Arms, tied by oval "Blagovsh-Nikolayev Parakh", repeated alongside, addressed to Japan, with violet Tsuruga (30 Oct) transit and "Ojiya" (1 Nov) arrival pmk below. It appears that the card was transported from Blagoveshchensk, via Amur River to Nikolayev and from there by C.E.R Manchurian ship line to Vladivostok and then by ship to Japan, fine and unusual river mail usage 500.00

- 1151 1900 (15 Feb) registered cover from Port Arthur to Santa Rosa, Calif., franked on back with vertical pair of unoverprinted 10k dark blue, tied by Russian Post Office Port Arthur departure cds, with Russian "Shanghai" (22 Feb) and additional "Pochtowaya Kontora Shanghai" (6.III.00) alongside, sent via Nagasaki and Yokohama, with Santa Ana and San Francisco Registered datestamps on arrival. The fascinating feature of this cover is the incorrect (non-hyphenated) "PORTARTHUR" Registry label (instead of "Port-Arthur"), unrecorded, v.f. 500.00

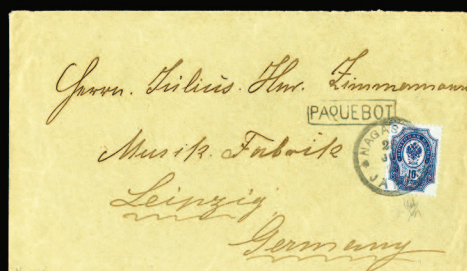

- 1152 ☒ 1901 (19 Dec) picture postcard (Kremlin), sent from Moscow, 4k Russian franking tied by ordinary Railway departure pmk, addressed to Austria (Ostrava), mistakenly routed via Siberia, Port Arthur, Chinese and Russian Post Offices in Chefoo and Shanghai, Victoria (Hong Kong), finally arriving in Ostrava on 26 March, 1902. A fantastic voyage around the world and across two Oceans, instead of a short direct route by railway from Moscow, via Warsaw to Vienna (web photo) 500.00
- 1153 ☒ 1903 (4 Aug) cover from Vilnius to a technician Alexander Vasilecky, with the Chinese Eastern Railway south branch at Port Arthur, franked on back with previously used Russian 7k, surrounded by four strikes of "0", obviously not recognized as valid by the postal official and charged "14k" penalty postage due ("Doplatit" to pay on front), TPO transits 123 (Samara-Chelyabinsk), 167 (Chelyabinsk-Omsk), 261 (Manchuria-Harbin), 266 (Port Arthur-Harbin) and finally 28 Aug. 1903 arrival, fine incoming cover from present-day Lithuania, with plethora of postal markings (web photo) 500.00
- 1154 ☒ 1903 (29 Aug) cover with 10k Kitai franking sent from Chefoo to England, via Port Arthur, showing violet "Liu Kung Tan" date stamp cds, Moscow transit and Ashford Sep 28 arrival pmks on back, coverflap mending, otherwise fine 250.00
- 1155 ☒ 1903 cover to Manchester, England, franked with China pair of 5c CIP Coiling Dragon, tied by framed letterbox, with 10k "Kitai" added alongside, tied by Shanghai Russian Post Office pmk, with additional transit and oval Peking on back, Moscow (17 Oct), Manchester arrival, some toning, otherwise a fine combination 250.00



- 1156 ☒ 1905 (19 Sep) picture postcard (view of Blagoveshchensk) to Finland with Finnish message, datelined "Post Saint Mary Magdalen. Aigun, Manchuria 19 Sept 1905", violet circular free-frank cachets around Imperial Eagle "Post Saint Mary Magdalen" and "Supervisory Administration of Post Saint Mary Magdalen" transit, following day in Blagoveshchensk, Helsinki arrival 2 XI 1905 (New Style). The Chinese fortress and town of Aigun, on the River Amur opposite Blagoveshchensk, was destroyed during the Sino-Russian conflict of 1900 by the Russians, who established a military base in the area and named it Post Saint Mary Magdalen. A FPO is said to have operated there from July 1901 to October 1903. No material known. The post was served by the Amur Steamship Company. This card shows that Post Saint Mary Magdalen continued to be manned throughout the Russo-Japanese War, when its mail was evidently handled on the Russian side of the River Amur at Blagoveshchensk 500.00
- 1157 ☒ 1913 Romanov 7k stationery entire envelope uprated with 4k red, used from Harbin 28.3.13, with three oval strikes of Railroad Station markings, addressed to Germany, fine and attractive 250.00
- 1158 ☒ 1914 (18 Aug) 4k stationery card overprinted "Kitai", written in German and sent from Chefoo to Vienna, with Red Cross Bureau for the Prisoners of War cachet in French (St. Petersburg Red Cross Committee marking), violet three-line Censor handstamp applied in St. Petersburg, another "Zens." in Austria, interesting item sent during the first days of WWI, obviously by a foreign national, whose mail was treated as coming from a Prisoner of War, showing early St. Petersburg censor cachet, exceptional example of mail delivery between two countries at war 500.00
- 1159 ☒ 1916 (16 Sep) unsealed cover to Tientsin, sent unpaid, with violet censor handstamp applied in Irkutsk, with "Tientsin Poste Russe" arrival pmk applied on arrival, fine and unusual 250.00
- 1160 ☒ 1917 (15 Dec) Chinese style cover (opened for display) from Borzya to Peking, franked with pair of 15k unoverprinted Arms, tied by "Borzya Zabaik." departure pmk, with a preprinted address, 5k "Kitai" overprinted adhesive on back, tied by Peking (22.12.17) pmk in Cyrillic, with Chinese arrival on front, fine and unusual cover from Borzya (a town and the administrative center of Borzinsky District in Zabaykalsky Krai, 349 kilometers southeast of Chita) 500.00

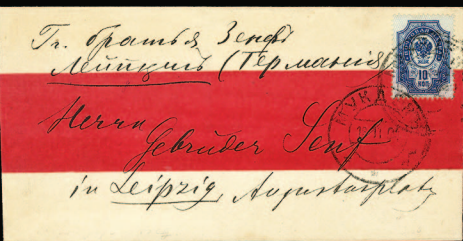

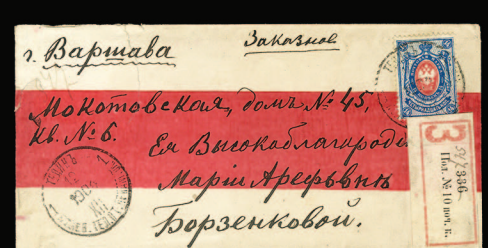

- 1161 ☒ 1918 (14 Dec) registered cover (opened for display) with Manchuria departure pmk, corresponding Registry label, addressed to Station Slyudyanka, showing two line handstamp indication that postage of 1r and 5k was paid in cash, also with arrival pmk on back, fine and incredibly rare Paid By Cash cover from Manchuria 500.00
- 1162 ☒ 1918 (14 Mar) registered cover from Peking to Kharkov, franked with pair of 10c on 10k surcharged, tied by "Peking" departure cds in Cyrillic, repeated alongside, corresponding Registry label at left, endorsed on back flap "Return because Post Office was closed due to Military Activities", cover returned to Peking, with 23.5.1918 arrival on back. An interesting historical usage from Russian Offices in China to regime-changing city of Kharkov (on 8th April 1918, the German army took control of Kharkov and shortly thereafter all Bolshevik gains in Ukraine were lost. The "green armies" and Insurgent Army of Ukraine refused to subordinate to Germany and Pavlo Skoropadsky proclaimed the Hetmanate, with himself as monarch). On 25th May, 1918, the Czech Legion revolted in Siberia and communication between Russian and European China completely collapsed (web photo)..... 500.00

- 1164 ☒ 1904 (14 Feb) registered cover from Kwangchentze (Changchun) to Paris, franked on back with two each 3k and 7k Arms, tied by departure cds, with Postal Car No.260 transit (22.II) and Paris arrival (24.3) alongside. There is an additional departure and corresponding Registry label "Kwangchentze Polevaya P-T-Kontora" label and large "R" in circle on front, some cover toning, otherwise fine, scarce usage (Tchilingirian : "No material known to the authors") 500.00
- 1165 ☒ 1911-12 two (Japanese) picture postcards from "St.Ashike" to Warszawa, each franked with 3k red, tied by oval "Harbin-Vladivostok 263", with arrival pmks, written in Polish ("please send closed envelopes") fine and scarce usage from St.Ashike to Warszawa 300.00
- 1166 ☒ 1913 (13 May) picture post card to Scotland, with 4k franking tied by oval (May 9 3 "1" of year omitted) "Manchuria" Railroad station, repeated alongside, fine and scarce, late usage 250.00

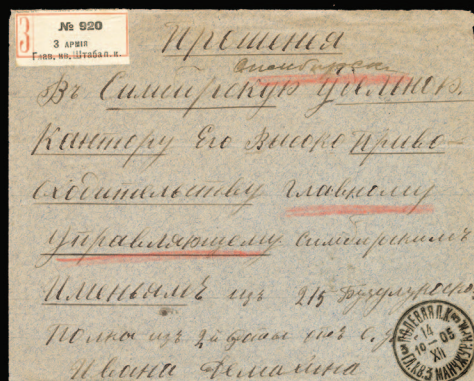

- 1168 ☒ 1904 (18 Nov) red-band cover franked with unoverprinted 10k dark blue, tied by Mukden departure cds, repeated below, sent to Germany, with boxed "Razryshenyo Polkovnik" (allowed by Colonel) censor cachet, with the Colonel's signature, v.f. and most unusual example of civilian mail through military censor 300.00

- 1169 ☒ 1904 (19 Nov) red-band stampless cover to Riga, showing a solid strike of "Dalny-Kwantun.Ob. Zhelezno-Dorog." departure cds, with military cachets and Riga (13.12.04) arrival pmks. Situated in Kwantung Province at the end of Lyaotung Peninsula and not far from Port Arthur, the port of Dalny was one of the first places to fall to the Japanese. The Russians abandoned the city in May 1904. The staff of the Dalny Railway Post Office relocated to Kaiyuan Station on Line Nos.265/266 of the C.E.R., from where it continued in service until November 1904. This cover may be the latest date known from Kaiyan (the relocation of "Sedentary" Post Offices during the Russo-Japanese War was discussed by Dr.Casey in the Post-Rider No.52, June 2003) 500.00
- 1170 ☒ 1904 (12 Dec) registered red-band cover from "Telin" (Tiehling) to Warszawa, franked with 14k carmine & blue, tied by "Telin Polev. Tel. Ot. Priam.Ok." cds, repeated alongside, supported by Registered label "No.10 F.P.O.", with red Warszawa 7.1.05 arrival on back, minor cover tears, otherwise fine, signed Carl Lange, with copies of articles of British Journal of Russian Philately Nr.46 (1971), describing this cover as being the only one known 500.00
- 1171 ☒ 1904 (23 Oct) Insured money letter for 30 rubles sent by officer with 12th Siberian (Barnaul) Infantry Regiment to Germany, franked on reverse 4k,10k and 20k (tone spot). Wax seals and cancelations read "Siberian Army Corps Field Post Office No.4", the latter applied 22.10.04, with another strike the next day; passed to Mukden Post Office No.24 received at Head Field Post Office (Harbin) 29 (10) 04, Registry label partly torn off. The violet circular cachet of District HQ of Administration of Military District of the Army in Manchuria, applied as a censor mark before the seals were affixed, suggests that this Siberian Army Corps FPO was situated in Mukden. Only one other example of the double-circle Mukden canceler with serial "a" has been recorded, while the Head FPO canceler of small (25mm) format has not been reported previously 250.00
- 1172 ☒ 1904 (1 Aug) free frank cover to Riga, with oval violet Field Hospital Lifland Red Cross cachet, corresponding handstamp and Postal Car No.1 TPO cancel, with Riga arrival, fine and scarce 250.00



- 1173 ☒ 1904 (24 Apr) free-frank cover, with letter addressed to "Manchuria. Gunzhulin (Kungchuling). To the General Staff of the Commander-in-Chief of all the Armed Forces. To the Senior Adjutant of the Intelligence Department, Lt.-Colonel of the General Staff Baron Viteken". Sent by wounded officer recuperating in St Petersburg voicing his suspicions that the British Military Observer with the Russian forces in Manchuria, Colonel Waters, is spying for the Japanese and wants him placed under surveillance (following receipt of this letter, the accreditation of Col. Waters was withdrawn and on attempting to return to Manchuria from leave, he was stopped at Irkutsk and made to turn back). The envelope bears a St. Petersburg cds of 24 4 05 and receipt cds of "Headquarters Field Post Office "d" (29.5.05)", also red crayon "Handed to Lt.-Col 29.V" (Wallscourt Walters, who became a Brigadier-General, was Military Attache in St Petersburg 1893-1898, observer with the Russian Army in Manchuria 1904-05 and chief of the British Military Mission at Russian GHQ in 1916. His book "Secret and Confidential" (1926) describes the Irkutsk incident) 500.00
- 1174 ☒ 1904 (2 Sep) stampless lettercard to Station Skhodnya, Nikolaevsk Railway, dateline MUKDEN, nobility logo inscribed in blue "Gift of his Royal Highness Grand Duke Mikhail Aleksandrovich", posted "Field Post Office 3.17th Army Corps" (at Mukden during autumn 1904) 250.00
- 1175 ☒ 1904 (13 Sep) Chinese native pictorial cover to Zwolen (Radom Guberniya), canceled "Siberian Army Corps Field Post Office No.4" (b), Radom transit and Zwolen arrival (8.10.04), circular violet free-frank cachet reading around Imperial Eagle "Mobile Field Hospital of the 2nd Siberian Infantry Division" (This hospital must have received many of the 14,301 Russian wounded from the Battle of Liaoyang, concluded shortly before this item was sent) 250.00

1178	1905 (8 Mar) Pictorial envelope and letter on military-motif note paper, written in Kungchuling and canceled "TELIN" (Tiehling), sent to Biryuch, with blue departure cds, red military cachet, charged "160" in blue crayon, some toning and roughly opened, Tchilingirian (pages 456 and 473 "only one recorded so far on a stampless military letter")	500.00
1179	1905 (12 Aug) service military cover sent from the Active Army Reserve FPO No.12 (Ershitsiatse) to Telegraph branch of the 1st Army, missent FPO 31 and redirected and missent again, this time to TALADZHAO, with 9.9.05 arrival pmk, opened and resealed with official seals, redirected to its final destination (15th Field Telegraph branch), exceptional usage, parts of the cover replaced and mended, rare	250.00
1180	1905 (30 Nov) registered cover to Denmark, franked on back with combination Russia 1k and 3k Arms and 10k "Kitai", tied by Fieldpost Corps No.1 Post Office "b" pmks on both sides, supported by corresponding Registry label ("1st Siberian Corps"), "R" in circle, with Copenhagen (5.2.06) arrival pmk, rare registered usage, mistakenly paying 14k domestic, instead of 20k overseas Registry rate. The mixed franking of Imperial and Russian Offices in China adhesives on cover to a foreign destination is unusual (The 1st Siberian Corps was at the time in Taolaichao)	500.00
1181	1905 (18 Sep) picture postcard (military officer) to Bohemia and Moravia, with TAOLAICHAO departure cds, sent through the Field Post Office (24 Sep), with violet General Headquarters Manchurian Army (rear) censor hs, Red Cross "Russo-Dutch Medical Detachment" cachets and bilingual Iglau (11.11.05) arrival pmk, fine and intriguing usage from Taolaichao (postmark not recorded in Tchilingirian). The Dutch Red Cross was active in Manchuria during the war and provided medical assistance to the wounded soldiers of both sides. It was one of the few organizations that was allowed to operate there because it was neutral and had no political affiliations	500.00

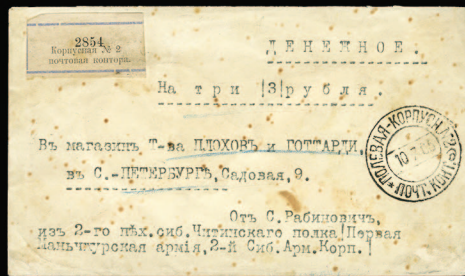

Gorodok" (Harbin Hospital Compound), with red cachet of 4th Harbin covered hospital, St. Petersburg arrival (14.6.05) arrival pmk, all on front. The wounded soldier writes giving thanks for a gift and that he was evacuated by Empress Maria's Military Medical Train from Station Kungchuling, to which the Russian GHQ moved after the fall of Mukden. Also included is an additional picture postcard depicting transport of wounded to a Harbin hospital 150.00
- 1185 ☒ 1905 (22 July) red-band cover to Austria, franked with three each 3k and 7k, paying 30k rate and tied by "Field Post Office 6th Siberian Corps (b)" cds, with corresponding cachet of "5th Battery 18th Artillery Brigade", registered, with large "R", endorsed "Via Vienna", with Reichenau (28.8) arrival pmk on back, fine 250.00

- 1188 ☒ 1905 (22 Jan) native Chinese style envelope sent from Mukden to Libau, violet "Lazaret 9th Infantry Regiment" ("Ivangorod Border to Estonia"), with arrival (16.II) on back, filing fold, otherwise fine usage from Mukden 250.00
- 1189 ☒ 1905 (16 Feb) red-band cover endorsed "From 1st Active Army" and registered to Simbirsk, franked 14k tied "12th Reserve Field Post Office a", no registration label, but manuscript "628/FUSHUN", Simbirsk 13 3 05 arrival backstamp along with intaglio cachet of 2nd Company 7th (Krasnoyarsk) Siberian Infantry Regiment. This cover confirms the location of 12th Reserve FPO at Fushun, on the Hun Ho, 40km ENE of Mukden. Three days after this cover was posted the office was evacuated in the face of the Japanese advance 300.00

- 1191 ☒ 1905 (29 Jan) decorative Chinese cover to Moscow with circular violet free-frank cachet of 3rd Division 35th Artillery Brigade (faint strike) plus circular datestamp of "Field Post Office 1 No. 27". FPO No. 27 was attached to 3rd Manchurian Army and opened September 1904 at "Suyantun" (Suchiatung) a station of the Chinese Eastern Railway immediately south of Mukden. After the Battle of Mukden (23 Feb-10 March 1905) the Russian Army retreated to the north and FPO 27 moved to Koukiatien (Gouotszydyan), fine cover, signed Maslowski 250.00
- 1192 ☒ 1905 (12 Apr) card addressed to the President of Russo-Dutch (Medical) detachment in St Petersburg written from Talaita by a staff Captain in charge of Railway Field Corps. Free-frank cachet in blue "Base Commandant TAOLAICHZHAO" and circular datestamp of "30th Reserve Field Post Office 'b'" (12.4.05). This card fixes the location of Field Post Office No. 30 in April 1905 as Taolaichao, which had a station of the Chinese Eastern Railway (Line 265/266). 250.00
- 1193 ☒ 1905 (10 July) registered insured money letter for 3 rubles, franked on back with 3k and 14k Arms, sent from Field Corps No.2 to St. Petersburg, with two intact wax seals, Insured Correspondence Field Corps No.2, corresponding Registry label, arrival pmk, some cover toning and wear, otherwise fine 250.00
