On November 19, 1931, the American Clipper made its first passenger flight to Cristobal in Canal Zone, via Kingston, Jamaica and Barranquilla, Colombia. Pan-American technical advisor Charles Lindbergh was in command of the flight as far as Barranquilla, with Basil Rowe as co-pilot*) 1,000.00

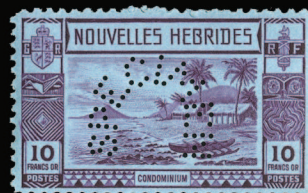
