A fine combination franking from New Hebrides, rare. (Founded in 1887, the Australasian New Hebrides Company provided shipping and mail services on steamers running between Australia and the New Hebrides, at intervals of about three weeks. This provided a convenient mail service to almost sixty islands in the grouping, including Tonga. This service proved to be unprofitable and the company closed down in 1899 and entered into a contract with the Australian Post Office) 1,000.00
